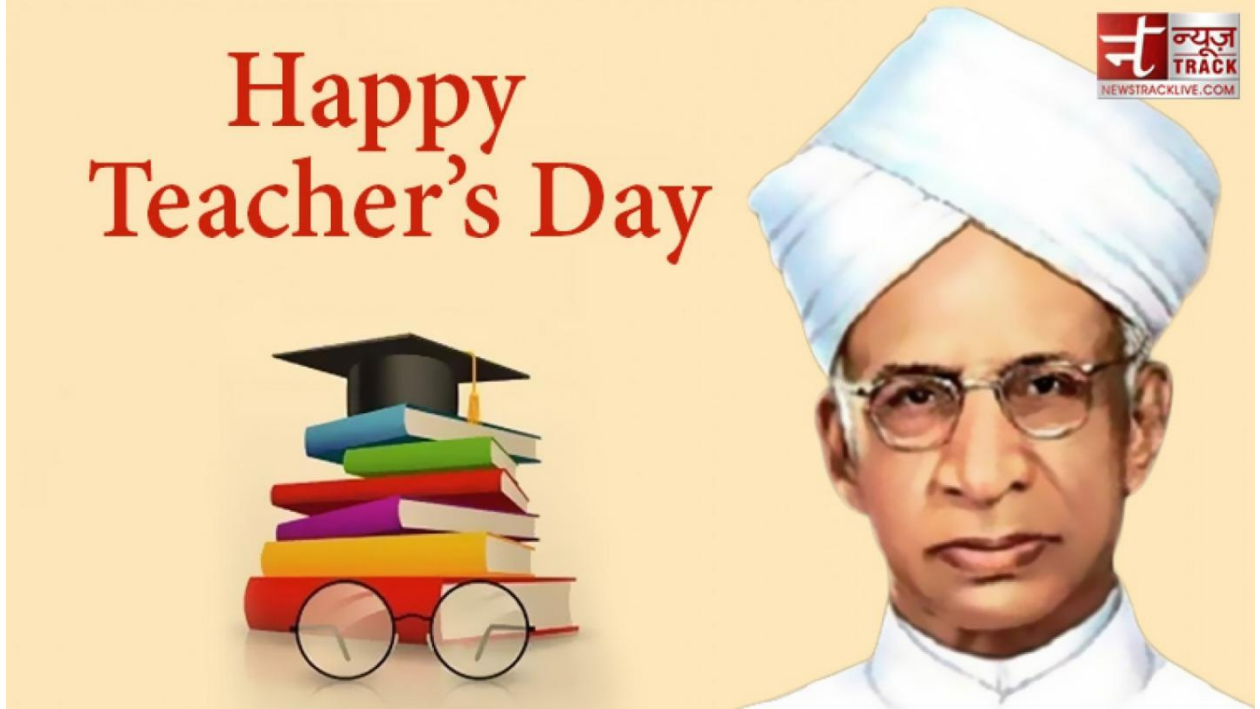

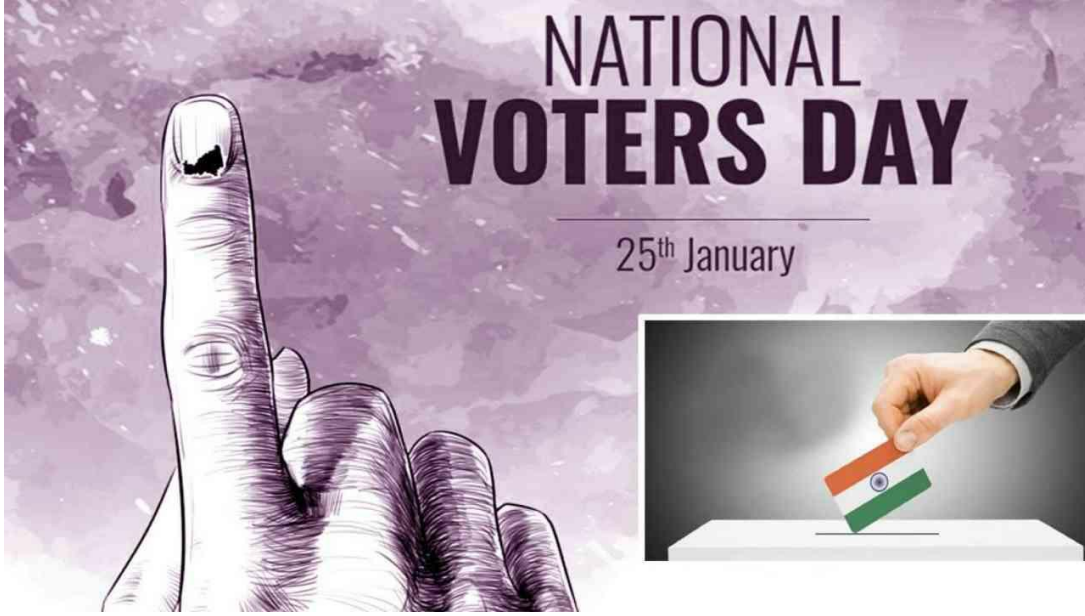

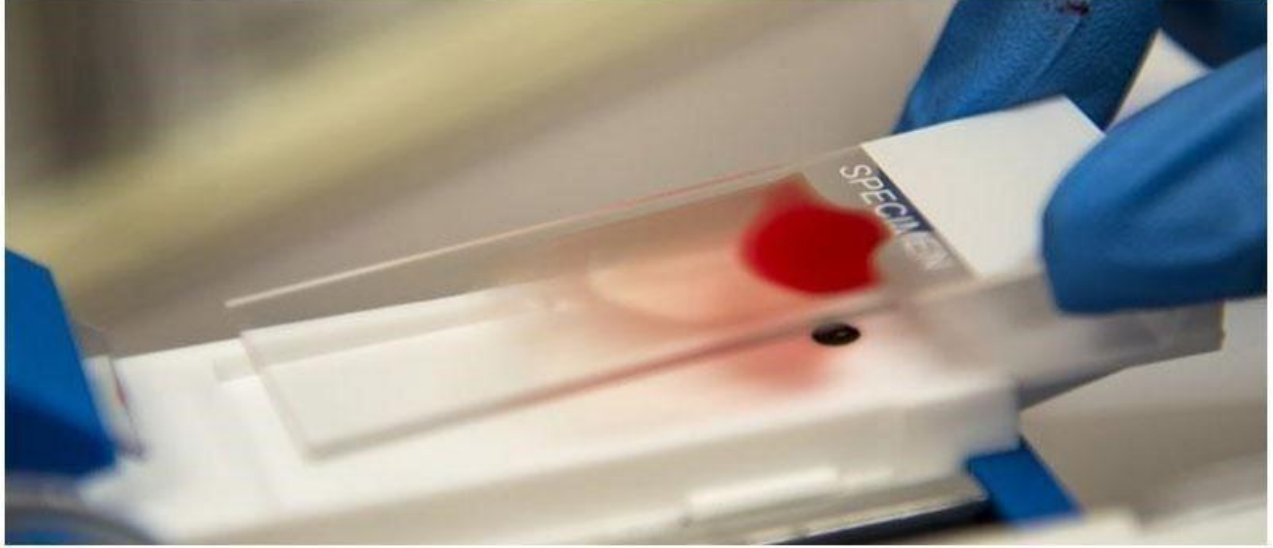

# **A REPORT ON THREE DAY WORK SHOP ON DIASTER MANAGEMENT**

## **SVCR GOVT DEGREE COLLEGE, PALAMANER**

The college has hosted a three day work shop on **Disaster Management** for the students of third year. The programme is organized by the Indian Red Cross Society, Chittoor and Your Service Department, (SETVEN) Tirupati from **21.8.17 to 23.08.17**.

43 students got enrolled for the programme from B.A. B.Com and B.Sc. The inaugural session was held on 21.08.17.

The inaugural ceremony took place on 21.08.17 from 10 am to 12 pm. The meeting is presided by the Principal Dr. P. Babu and Chief Guest Sri V.Srinivasa Reddy, District Fire Officer; Chittoor imparted the lecture on types of disaster and the methods to overcome them. The guests of honour, Sri Chankri Naik, Field Officer, SETVEN, Tirupati, Sri K. Purushotham Naidu, Secretary, IRCS, Palamaner branch, A.Surendra Reddy, CI of Police, Palamaner, Dr. R. Rajendra Reddy, Member, CPDC, Sri S.Seetharamaiah, Member, CPDC and Sri. M.Rambhoopal, SI of Palamaner gave lectures on methods to overcome disasters. Sri P. Veerabhadra Reddy, Lecturer in Botany and Coordinator of YRC Unit in the college briefed the programmed report.

12 pm to 1 pm: After the inaugural session the students are instructed on the topics of Natural disasters, the types and the effects and the methods to face them have been discussed by Sri Sreenivasa Reddy, District Fire Officer.

1 pm to 2 pm Lunch Break

2 pm to 4.30 pm: The Fire department held the entire session. They explained the topics of Fire fighting rescue techniques, preparation of knots and floating aids. All these topics are demonstrated with the aids in a natural way. The students are exposed to the conditions and learnt with firsthand information.

### **THE SECOND DAY WORK SHOP**

9 am to 10 am: A short recap of the last session's activities is given to the students by Sri P. Veerabhadra Reddy garu.

10 am to 1 pm: Sri S. Rathna Sekhar, first aid faculty, Tirupati took a long session and explained the topics of First aid. History of first aid and principles are discussed. He also described with demo the feature of V.I.P.'s of body, CPR Demonstration, Bites by Snakes and dogs, the wounds, injuries and poison cases and how to treat them at first. Tea and Biscuits are served in between the session.

1 pm to 2 pm Lunch Break

2 pm to 4 pm: 108 Services, Usage of Regular ambulance, anti shock position and the method to treat them, cardiac arrest and the procedure to save, and the emergency services answered are discussed.

In the same session Municipal authorizes explained on importance of sanitation and hygiene conditions in the surrounding. High tea along with biscuits is served.

### THE THIRD DAY WORK SHOP

9 am to 10 am : Sri Chakri Naik made the students to bring back the memories of the past classes. An initiation is done to make every student to utilize the dais.

10 am to 11.30 am: Sri. M.P. Naik, Traffic SI. Palamaner sensitized the students on road safety and traffic rules. Tea and biscuits is served.

11.45am to 1 pm: Dr.Sarada brought awareness on Communicable diseases and the Do's and Don'ts during heat waves, the illness protects during ageing and the first aid to be given during poison cases.

1 pm to 2 pm : Lunch break

2 pm to 3 pm: Feedback on the three day work shop is collected and a group discussion is followed on.

4 pm to 5 pm: Valedictory ceremony is conducted. The programme is presided by Dr. P. Babu, Principal. The Chief Guest of the evening was Sri B.Gangi Reddy, MD, Rathna Biotech, Kolamasanapalli. The Guests of Honour are Sri J.Srinivas, MRO, Palamaner, Sri K. Ramachandra Rao, Municipal Commissioner, Palamaner, Sri K. Purushotham Naidu, Secretary, IRCS, Palamaner appreciated the students for their devotion in attending the three day workshop. Formal thanks are levies by Sri P. Veerabhadra Reddy, Coordinator of the programme.
